



Restarting the Thursday International and Texas Scramble

Dear Member,

Recognizing the importance to our members and our Club both Captains and the Competition Committee have unanimously agreed that we should restart the Thursday International and Monthly Texas Scramble competitions.

However, they have also stated that the organization and the running of the competitions must comply with all the protocol COVID-19 regulations as they apply.

This is good news for many of us. We know that these competitions do not take place in July and August but start up again in September. Our plan is to do just that with our first Thursday International (TI) on the 17th of September followed by our Texas Scramble (TS) competition on the 19th September.

Please note that for now you cannot sign up on the Club Internet to play in these competitions. Unfortunately, our current system cannot accommodate this. If you cannot be present, then ask a friend to enroll you as per the instructions below:

How will it work?

1. Inscriptions will be made in person using a pre-printed form available in the caddie master's office or downloaded from the internet. The forms can be entered for two or four players in the TI and four players in the TS.

2. Instead of exact start times you will be asked to nominate one of three time slots, early, mid or late. Mark your preferred time slot with a 1 and your second preference with a 2.

3. The forms will be deposited in a separate box for the TI, and another one for the TS in the caddie masters office which will be emptied at 12:00 on the Monday (TI) or Wednesday (TS) before the competition.

Once emptied, inscriptions for the following week can again be deposited. (Only applicable for the Thursday International)

4. The order of play will be decided through a draw taking your indicated preferences into account as much as possible but, that can't be guaranteed. As before, the start list will be published at the club's website and at the notice board.

5. The playing fees will be €3.00 per person and prizes (Guadalminos) will be available from the caddie masters the day after each competition.

There will be NO prizegiving or lottery.

6. As the order of play is determined by a draw **THERE IS NO ADVANTAGE OF EARLY ENTRIES AND NO NEED FOR QUEING.** Entries on the last day have as much chance to be drawn first as those on the first day.

We are working to try and get back to enjoying our Club competitions but at the same time ensuring we are all staying safe and complying with all the protocols.

Please be patient and thank you for your understanding.
